

Internships in BARCELONA, SPAIN



The Office of International Education and CISabroad have partnered to offer SUNY Cobleskill students fall, spring, or summer internships in stylish Barcelona, Spain!

Location

An economic powerhouse, a center for business in Europe, and a culturally rich city, Barcelona is an incredible location for an international internship! Due to Barcelona's location, interns will also have the chance to learn more about the unique Catalan culture and improve their Spanish language abilities.

Housing

Participants will live in self-catered shared residences with other students and interns from around the world! Housing is located across Barcelona, generally only a short distance from each internship placement.

Excursions

In addition to on-the-job learning, excursions within the city will be available. Possible activities include a Catalan cooking class, a flamenco show, guides to local festivals, and activities to get to know Barcelona in-depth.

Internship Placements

Students can intern in a wide variety of areas such as Agricultural Business, Animal Science, Business Administration, Information Technology, Early Childhood Studies, Fisheries and Aquaculture, Wildlife Management, and Plant Science.

Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but candidates must apply at least 90 days before their intended internship start date.
