The Office of International Education and CISabroad have partnered to offer SUNY Cobleskill students fall, spring, or summer internships in awe-inspiring Cape Town, South Africa!

Location

Cape Town, South Africa's second-largest city, is one of the most picturesque and iconic places in the world. Nestled between Table Mountain and the Cape of Good Hope, Cape Town is alive with arts, music, and a plethora of festivals.

Housing

Participants will live in self-catered shared residences with other students and interns from around the world! Housing is located in the safe, student-friendly neighborhood near the University of Cape Town. Homestays can also be arranged upon request.

Excursions

Excursions and activities vary from term to term, but all students will visit Robben Island, UNESCO World Heritage Site and prison of Nelson Mandela, as part of the orientation to Cape Town.

Internship Placements

Students can intern in a wide variety of areas such as Agricultural Business Management, Animal Science, Business Administration, Information Technology, Early Childhood Studies, Fisheries and Aquaculture, Wildlife Management, and Plant Science.

Deadline

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but you must apply at least 90 days before your intended internship start date.
