#### **Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program – up to \$5,000**

Eligibility requirements:

- \* Enrolled as an undergraduate student at a two- or four-year U.S. institution
- \* United States citizen
- \* **Receiving a Federal Pell Grant** at the time of application or during the term of study abroad
- \* Participating in a study abroad program that is no less than four weeks in one country and no more than an academic year
- \* Receiving academic credit
- \* Study in any country not currently under a U.S. State Department Travel Warning or Cuba

#### **Boren Scholarship**

Boren Scholarships provide unique funding opportunities for U.S. undergraduate students to add an important international and language component to their educations. Awards are focused on geographic areas, languages, and fields of study that are critical to U.S. national security, broadly defined, and underrepresented in study abroad. ### **Bridging Scholarships: Japan – up to \$4,000**

The Bridging Scholarship program will award scholarships to American students participating in study-abroad programs in Japan in fall 2012. Undergraduate students majoring in any field of study and attending any recognized exchange or independent program in Japan are eligible to apply for these scholarships. Recipients of Bridging Scholarships will receive stipends of \$2,500 or \$4,000, depending on the length of their study program in Japan.
