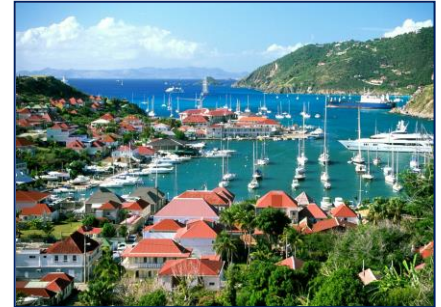




Winter 2014 Early Childhood in the CARIBBEAN!

COURSE: ECHD 354 Math and Science for Young Children, 3 credits. This academic travel program will broaden your knowledge of international early childhood education in the British West Indies. This course presents developmentally appropriate theory and methods of integrating math and science into curriculum for young children. Hands-on content and experience with the natural world will facilitate the planning and implementation of math and science curricula in an Early Childhood setting. **Fulfills a major course requirement.**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to SUNY students in good academic standing. **PREREQUISITE:** ECHD 150 and one science course or by permission of the instructor.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Observe and participate in a preschool or kindergarten program
- Design and implement developmentally and culturally appropriate math and science learning experiences
- Explore the coral reefs by boat and snorkeling
- Enjoy the beach and daily opportunities to swim in the Caribbean Sea
- Taste local island cuisine and mix with the locals
- Explore the island of St. Martin, including Butterfly Farm/National Nature Reserve



ESTIMATED COSTS: \$2,150 per participant. DOES NOT INCLUDE TUITION/FEES (add \$743 in-state). Includes group airfare from NYC, accommodation, most meals, program-related travel, international health insurance, program fee, instructional materials, and excursions/site visits. Participants will be responsible for passport expenses, additional meals, and personal spending money. Passports are required. **\$350 deposit due upon acceptance.** Financial aid may apply.
