Applicants for the Fall 2010-Spring 2011 School Year:

To apply for aid:

- 1. File on line at www.fafsa.ed.gov or mail in a completed **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** to the Federal Processor anytime after January 1, 2010.
- 2. All students who have been accepted and have a processed FAFSA on file here at Cobleskill will receive a financial aid award letter from us. Mailing of letters begins in mid March. This letter will contain estimates for such awards, as Pell, Stafford Loans, and TAP (NY Residents). Priority for aid from the college, such as Perkins Loans, and College Work Study, will be given to students whose FAFSA is successfully processed, on or before February 13, 2010. We typically are not able to offer College Work Study or Perkins to a student whose FAFSA is processed after February 13th, 2010.

Please note - estimates of 2009 income should be used on the FAFSA in order to meet the processing due date of **February 13th**, if 2009 federal returns have not been completed.
