

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL and

BEDFORD COUNTY TECHNICAL CENTER

September 2022 - September 2027

The State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill and Bedford County Technical Center jointly endorse this articulation agreement impacting the Bedford County Technical Center graduates successfully completing the Agriscience Program. It is the intent of this agreement to recognize the breadth and depth of this program as a foundation for students who matriculate at SUNY Cobleskill. A candidate¹ from Bedford County Technical Center who:

- 1. Receives a Pennsylvania State high school diploma
- Follows the Bedford County Technical Center Agriscience curriculum and achieves an 85 average or higher in each course included in the above curriculum and meets all other SUNY Cobleskill admission requirements for their major
- 3. Has a written recommendation from the Bedford County Technical Center Agriscience instructor

will be offered by SUNY College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill:

- 1. Guaranteed admission into a Plant Science or Agricultural Business major, provided that the student meets admission requirements for the program and there is availability within the program
- 2. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course ORHT 105 Introduction to Horticulture (3 semester credits)
- 3. Will receive advanced standing credit for SUNY Cobleskill's course AGBU 100 Beginning Agricultural Business (3 semester credits)
- 4. Will receive advanced standing credits for SUNY Cobleskill's course ANSC 111 Introduction to Animal Science (after student passes the challenge exam given during the first week of classes at SUNY Cobleskill (3 semester credits)

The student must complete and file a SUNY Cobleskill Admissions Application according to instructions. The letter of recommendation from the Agriscience Instructor must accompany the application stating the student attends this institution, which has an articulation agreement with SUNY Cobleskill.

The effective date of this agreement is September 1, 2022, and will be reviewed for renewal, five years after signing, by the participating parties.

¹ Persons not meeting these criteria have the option of applying to SUNY Cobleskill under regular admission procedure.
